



Parents Code of Conduct

Thank you for supporting your daughter in a very important role within the GenuWin Reign Softball program; a parent or guardian is often a major influence in a young person's life. Attitudes, actions, and behaviors perceived by the athletes frequently affect the players. You may take the game very seriously, but don't forget to have fun and display good sportsmanship, as you are setting an example for not only your child, but their teammates and all the young athletes on the fields, as well. Your role is to promote sportsmanship and build relationships in a positive light while remembering the kids are to be having fun! All parents will abide by all rules and regulations listed below.

1. Let the coaches coach!!
2. Recognize the value and importance of coaches, umpires, board members and volunteers alike. Give them their due respect. Without them, there would be no softball program.
3. No parent or fan may possess illicit drugs at practices or any GenuWin Reign activity or games (home or away).
4. No parent or fan shall physically or verbally abuse other parents, fans, coaches, players, or umpires (including opponents).
5. All parents and fans shall conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. No yelling, booing, teasing, or cheering if another player is hurt. No profane or abusive language or unsportsmanlike gestures of any kind are tolerable.
6. Any unlawful actions will be reported to the proper authorities and are grounds for immediate dismissal from the program.
7. No parent shall interfere with practices, games, or coaching at any time. At no time is a parent to enter the practice, dugout or playing field unless specifically requested to do so by the team manager. Parents should observe a 24 hour cooling period after games or practices to discuss any problems. (Please be sure to approach a coach.) Please keep in mind that playing time is at the discretion of the team manager.
 - Please notify the coach if your child will miss a practice or a game as far in advance as possible.
 - Please arrive in enough time that players are ready before the scheduled beginning of practice, and pick up your child at the designated end of practice.
 - Participation is NOT to be an excuse for unfinished homework – help your child plan their time wisely.
8. GenuWin Reign families are expected to support the GenuWin Reign and its projects, such as fundraising, community involvement, etc.
9. Softball is an active sport. I understand that injuries may occur, and that GenuWin Reign, its staff and coaches and related entities are not responsible or liable for injuries that may occur.
10. In no form, is a parent/guardian to solicit any coach of another team within the Genuwin Reign organization for the sole benefit of their player. Disciplinary action will be enforced by the board.



11. Parents are required to meet all financial obligations to the organization, including the \$600 non refundable registration fee and all fees and other obligations. Agreeing to a spot on an GenuWin Reign Softball team obligates you to the full posted or otherwise expressly agreed upon cost for the season. All fees are non-refundable. Any player non-compliant with this rule will be suspended from practice and play until their account is brought up to date. Payments or balances that are more than 30 days late without express approval from the Board of Directors will be subject to a finance charge until brought current. In the event that you have any outstanding amounts due to GenuWin Reign Softball and GenuWin Reign pursues legal means of collection, you shall be responsible for any and all attorney fees, court costs, and other costs of collection, including any post-judgment attorney fees or litigation costs, that GenuWin Reign incurs in order to collect sums due by You.

Any Parent or Other Non-Participating Family Member found to be in violation of any of the above will be handled in the following manner:

A verbal warning will be given to the Family for the first violation.

Second violation will result in a removal from game/practice with the player.

Any repeat violation may result with a Family Suspension or Removal from the team.
