

Players Code of Conduct

All Players will abide by all rules and regulations listed below.

- 1. I will represent myself, my family, my team, and the GenuWin Reign Softball Organization with dignity and integrity at all times.
- 2. I will play with pride, respect, and integrity regardless of the circumstances of the game.
- 3. I will be a teammate first. I will always hustle on/off the field for every play.
- 4. No Player is to use or be under the influence of or in the possession of drugs, alcohol or tobacco products at any time.
- 4. No Player is to physically or verbally abuse any Manager, Coach, Assistant, Fellow Player, Opponent or Umpire. Players are not to be disruptive during games or practices. Players are to maintain a positive attitude at all times. Our organization will not in any way tolerate a player questioning the call of an umpire or the making of disparaging remarks or gestures in regards to an umpire's call. Respect the game, umpires, and opposing teams at all times.
- 5. No Player is to use abusive or profane language in the presence of ANYONE connected with the GenuWin Reign. At all times, players must conduct themselves in a mature sportsmanlike manner. No unsportsmanlike gestures, yelling, booing, teasing, or cheering if another player is hurt. Win or lose, all players must display sportsmanship and congratulate their opponents.

Any unlawful actions will be reported to the proper authorities, and are grounds for immediate dismissal from the program.

- 6. No team member shall throw her/his bat, helmet, glove or any object in disgust on or off the playing field at any time.
- 7. All Players are expected to keep their grades up, and are not to be a disciplinary problem at school. Any school or law enforcement punishment will be upheld by GenuWin Reign. (i.e. a child suspended from the program for the same amount of time, possibly resulting in a game suspension.)
- 8. Any Player returning from a physical injury requiring a doctor's care must present a signed physician's release to the organization, and the release will need to be presented to the Manager before the Player is allowed to resume play or practice.
- 9. Players must listen to and follow the directions of all Coaches and accept the coaches' decisions regarding playing positions and the amount of playing time. This is a Travel Team and there are no guarantees for equal playing time or position.
- 10. Players must attend scheduled practices. In order for an absence to be excused, Players must notify their Manager and receive prior approval.
- 11. Excused absence: Manager must be notified and grant approval of excused absence. More than 2 excused absences during a practice week may affect playing time. Manager will determine if an excused absence is warranted.
- 12. Unexcused absence: Manager was not notified in advance; calling in to miss practice. First unexcused absence will affect playing time. Second unexcused absence Player will be benched



for one (1) game. Third unexcused absence will result in Player being ineligible to play for two (2) games and a formal warning to Parents. Fourth unexcused absence may result in removal from the team.

- 13. All Players are to arrive at their game or practice at the time assigned by the coach and may be benched for failure to do so.
- 14. All Players are not to have jewelry on at practices or games and will not be allowed to perform if wearing jewelry. All jewelry must be removed in order to participate in practice or games.
- 15. Players are to treat all hotels, facilities; including practice facilities, GenuWin Reign property and equipment with respect (uniform included). Uniforms should only be worn at scheduled games or as otherwise instructed by your manager. When wearing a GenuWin Reign uniform, you must show good sportsmanship at all times; failure to do so may result in the dismissal from the GenuWin Reign program. You are responsible for the condition of your uniforms.
- 16. Players must participate in all scheduled fundraising/charity programs unless excused by the team manager or organization (depending on host of the fundraising activity).
- 17. Be Coachable. Listen to your coaches' instruction. Ask questions if you are not sure. Be willing to try new positions, new techniques. Be willing to do whatever your team needs you to do.
- 18. In no form, is a player to solicit another coach within the Genuwin Reign organization during their current season for the purpose of switching teams. Disciplinary action will be determined by the board
- 19. Any Player found to be in violation of any of the above will be handled in the following manner:

A verbal warning will be given to the Player/Parent for the first violation.

Second violation will result in a removal from game/practice.

Any repeat violation may result with a Suspension or Removal from the team.
